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CHAPELLE-CHAMBERTIN 2014

94 POINTS - \$225 - 8 CASES IMPORTED - RED

A broad, fruity style, this exhibits black cherry, violet, crushed stone and spice aromas and flavors. Features a firm grip of tannins, with a beam of acidity and a long, sweet finish. Best from 2023 through 2042. – B.S

LATRICIÈRES-CHAMBERTIN 2014

94 POINTS - \$225 - 10 CASES IMPORTED - RED

Intense aromas of cherry, earth, mineral and spice mark this youthful red. The cherry core continues through the lingering finish, while the structure builds and elements of oak, earth and mineral add interest. Burly in the end. Best from 2021 through 2036. – B.S

CHAMBERTIN-CLOS DE BÈZE 2014

93 POINTS - \$300 - 10 CASES IMPORTED - RED

A lean, sinewy style, boasting cherry, currant, spice and leafy flavors. This is coiled like a steel wire, with well-integrated tannins and spice notes dominating the finish. Best from 2022 through 2038. – B.S

GEVREY-CHAMBERTIN AU CLOSEAU 2014

93 POINTS - \$120 - 10 CASES IMPORTED - RED

A concentrated nugget of cherry is bound up in the depths of this red. Features a silky exterior and holds together well, flexing some tannins on the finish. Should come into its own in a few years. Best from 2020 through 2035. – B.S

GEVREY-CHAMBERTIN CLOS PRIEUR 2014

93 POINTS - \$120 - 10 CASES IMPORTED - RED

This appealing red balances flesh, juiciness and flavors of cherry, black currant and spice. Shows depth and complexity, capped by a lingering aftertaste of mineral and spice. Best from 2020 through 2035. – B.S
